THE JEWISH THEATRE COLLABORATIVE will mark Women's History Month March 29 when they present a performance entitled "Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Well Being," a celebration of Lillian Wald, a Jewish nurse who pioneered public health and worker safety. The performance will feature Jamie M. Rea as Wald. Rea recently won critical acclaim as Charlotte Salomon in JTC's production "Life? or Theater?"

Jason Glick will play opposite Rea in several roles.

The script was developed by Doren Elias of the Traveling Lantern Theatre Company, a Portland-based touring company that presents stories for children.

Elias previously played opposite Rea as Amadeus Daberlohn in "Life? or Theater?"

The Tuesday performance is set for 7 p.m. at the Mittleman Jewish Community Center, 6651 SW Capitol Hwy. Tickets are \$12 for adults and \$8 for seniors.
